## **EJECTIONS**

### **Information for Commissioners and Officials**

**When a coach or player is ejected**, that night or the following day:

1. Official notifies commissioner.
2. Commissioner notifies school in writing (OSAA ejection report).
3. Commissioner notifies OSAA in writing (OSAA ejection report) --- send to Marla Starkman; [marlas@osaa.org](mailto:marlas@osaa.org) or Fax 503.682.0960.

#### **Reminders**

1. If a player or a coach is ejected, the ejecting official must report it.
2. Ejected coach must leave the area immediately and be out of sight and sound. This is an OSAA Rule and a NFHS Rule.
3. Officials are NOT to interpret OSAA policy; only NFHS playing rules of the sport.

#### **Appeal Process**

1. School will communicate with the commissioner.
2. Commissioner will communicate with the ejecting official(s).
3. OSAA will communicate with commissioner and school.
4. OSAA will notify school of appeal approval or denial after working with commissioner.

#### **Physical contact WITH official**

1. Offending coach or player shall be immediately ejected. Ejected coach must leave the area and be out of sight and sound. This is an OSAA Rule and a NFHS Rule.
2. Commissioner and Athletic Director notify OSAA the next day.

#### **Physical contact BY official**

May result in required appearance before OSAA Executive Board and could result in probation, suspension or revocation.
