1	9--1--1	Non-players on Team bench
2		Non-players stand for good play
3		Non-players stand for sub
4	(12-2-6)	Head coach stand - in zone
5	9--1--2	Teams located on side of playing area
6	9--2--1	Changing sides
7	9-2-2a	Court Protocol - No team should have an advantage by getting to their bench and talking to their coach. This is where the protocol comes from.
8		Court Protocol - Watch for issues of last few girls stopping at bench. Give verbal warning before penalizing.
9	9-2-2b	Released - Teams who are excited may not be paying attention, this official continued to follow procedure properly. For younger teams you may want them to follow protocol to learn.

Live Ball Becomes Dead When:		
12	9-3-3a	Touches Net Antennas
13		Does not pass between antennas
14		Passes completely beyond centerline extended to other side of court.
15	9-3-3b	Lands out of bounds
16	9-3-3c	Contacts ceiling, not legally played
N/P	9-3-3d	Contacts ceiling, after 3rd hit
N/P	9-3-3e	Ball contacts wall/ceiling over non-playable area
N/P	9-3-3f	Motionless in net/overhead obstruction
17	9-3-3g	Touches Floor
N/P	9-3-3h	Passes under the net
18	9-3-3i	Contacts non-team member in playable area
19	9-3-3j	Breaks plane of non-play area and out of reach
20	9-3-3k	Referees Whistle
N/P	9-3-3l	Timer interrupts play in Referees opinion
