

Touch Vs. Out Of Bounds (Casebook pg 10 - 2-3-1d)

1	Touch	First Shank Off First Pass - Blue/Green Teams
2	Touch	First Shank Off Dig - White/Black & White Teams
3	Touch	First Shank Off Blocked - Black/Black Teams
4	Touch	Second Hit Shank to Score Table ... Not out of bounds because it hit non-playing person, still touch, stayed on same side of net.
5	Touch	Second Hit Shank (Cannot see first hit - trying to save without hitting net.
6	Out of B	Attack Out of Bounds - Blue/Green Teams
7	Out of B	Tip Out of Bounds (Black Teams)
8	Out of B	Tip Out of Bounds - Different View
9	Out of B	Ball returned off dig that goes out of bounds - antenna appears to not be an issue - black/black team
10	Out of B	Ball out of bounds off block - R1 confuses issues by calling touch and then out of bounds.
11	Antenna	Attack Hits Antenna - R2 immediately sees it.
12	Antenna	Attack Hits Antenna From Out of Court Attacker - White/White teams
13	Antenna	Attack Hits Antenna - Linesperson catches it?
14	Center Line Extended	Return Ball Outside of Antenna - Far view, 3rd hit returned outside of antenna, caught by linesperson
15	Center Line Extended	Return Ball Outside of Antenna - OoB because it went past the out of bounds line extension behind the R1 (green/blue)
16	Center Line Extended	Return Ball Behind R1, R2 gives discreet, R1 gives double signal, first one incorrect. Only out of bounds because it passed behind line extended.
17	OoB Net	Pass hits net outside of antenna - out of bounds correct call.
18	OoB Net	Pass hits net outside of antenna - out of bounds correct call.
19	OoB Net	Pass hits the R1 who is an extension of the out of bounds area from the antenna to stand.
20	OoB Net	Tough call from camera angle but R1 uses lines judge to help with call. May have hit outside of antenna or just landed out.
21	Unusual Sit.	Attacked Ball Rolls along Net - Did the blockers even touch, if not what would the call be if the ball had landed out of bounds?
22	Touch	Watch right side of net, touch or 4 hits? NFHS does not recommend the touch call being used as an informal signal. Here is a good reason. The R1 gave a touch call publically when to everyone else it was clearly not touched.
