VOLLEYBALL OFFICIALS UNIFORM State Adoptions / 2016

2016-17 NFHS Volleyball Rules Book / Rule 5.3 / Page 20

Article 1 --- The officials uniform shall be:

- a. An all-white, short-sleeved collared polo shirt;
- b. Black slacks;
- c. Solid black athletic shoes and black socks.

Article 2 --- Referee equipment shall include:

- a. For the first referee, a whistle, a set of yellow and red cards, a coin and a watch.
- b. For the second referee, a whistle, lineup "card," a pen/pencil, a set of yellow and red cards, a coin and a watch.

OSAA STATE ADOPTIONS *(allowed but not required for local association adoption)*

1. Officials may wear **professional looking black shorts** with the following restrictions:
 - a. for invitational tournaments only;
 - b. an entire crew shall wear them;
 - c. last date allowed is October 2, 2016;
 - d. solid black athletic shoes and black socks shall be worn. EXCEPTION: Crews may wear solid white athletic shoes and socks with shorts, but shall abide by (a), (b) and (c) in this section.
2. Officials may wear an **all-white, long-sleeved collared polo shirt**.
3. Officials may wear an **all-white, long-sleeved, v-neck sweater** over their all-white, short-sleeved collared polo shirt.

Notes:

- The OSAA patch shall be worn above the left pocket area of the shirt.
- The OSAA patch is the only item permissible on the front of the polo shirt or sweater.
- The OSAA patch is required and shall be visible at all times.
- Association name is permissible on the sleeve of the polo shirt.
- An American flag is permissible on the opposite sleeve of the polo shirt.
- If slacks have belt loops, a black belt shall be worn.
- Lanyards are to be (1) black or white in color, (2) a solid color. They are to be free of any wording or logos.
- Whistles shall be black.
